

Seattle Prep Committee Meeting 8/27/16—MINUTES

Attending: President Michelle Kimihira, Board Member Jeanne Peterson, Ginger Ferguson and Sarah Visser. Absent: Rick Shrum, Lene Russell, Phil Calvert, Kelly Forebaugh and Curtis Bigelow

The committee would like the following to be discussed with Seattle Prep on the September 15th meeting:

1. Cars should be registered and have a sticker/hanging tag. This is a common practice amongst other schools in the area.
2. The agreement specifies that NCHNA can get a list of registered cars. Obtain the list.
3. Request for Seattle Prep to hire a traffic controller to streamline traffic and laws are obeyed. There have been a number of reports of parents blocking driveways.
4. Is it true that the garage costs \$100/month for students and requires carpooling?
5. The neighborhood liaison is ineffective. Need him to have accountability. He should call the police rather than asking neighbors to do it. For example, students are still parking in RPZ zone.
6. We no longer receive a calendar of events. Request this be sent out so neighbors know when to expect parking issues.
7. Update handbook to clarify laws instead of “follow the laws.”
8. Buses should not be parking on the residential street. Designate a proper area for buses
